CALL TO ORDER – July 25, 2007

Meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. by Chairman, Joe Jaynes in the Anderson-Price Memorial Building.

MINUTES

Marty Press moved to approve the minutes as written. Benny Woodham seconded. All members present voted to approve.

UPDATE FROM CHAIR

Joe formally thanked all members for their participation in all the previous work required to achieve the Letter of Designation from FDOT. Dick Pflieger expressed gratitude on behalf of the citizenry for the CAG's perseverance and commitment to get the job done.

UPDATES FROM FDOT/COUNTY/CITY

Elizabeth Matej reported that the City is putting text amendments from the CMP into the Comp Plan. Amendments will be reviewed by the Planning Commission at the August 9 meeting at 7:00 p.m.

Lauren mentioned that the State mandates specific items from the CMP must be included in the County Comp Plans. She also noted there are four Scenic Highways in Volusia County. The County is working with the State on how to amend the County Comprehensive Plan in the most efficient way possible while incorporating the differing needs of the individual Scenic Highways. Rita mentioned that OSLT recommends a deeper/wider buffer along Old Dixie Highway, Walter Boardman Lane, Highbrige Road, etc. (175 feet rather than 50 feet.) We realize that other Scenic Highways, and the A1A portion of OSLT, may not have this same need. OSLT may accomplish this goal via an overlay.

Garry Balogh reported via e-mail that the sign shop started fabricating FSH signs on July 23. They will ship on July 31. FDOT Traffic Operations issued the work order to install signs on SR A1A and SR 40. Garry will meet with County representatives Jean Parlow and Jon Cheney on July 31 to discuss sign installation on County roads and removal of existing County scenic route signs. Elizabeth reported there are no issues with signs within the City limits. All will be placed within existing right-of-ways.

CME ACTION AND DISCUSSION ITEMS

In accordance with OSLT By-laws established 8/23/2006, the following members were nominated for Board of Directors: Rob Bird, Richard Gardner, Karon Jaynes, Ann Kashmer, Mary-Lu Leveroni, Rick Smith. Rick Gardner moved and Ginger Young seconded to accept the nominations. Motion passed unanimously. The above

named members, along with existing officers Joe Jaynes, Laura Bamberger and Paula Wehr, now comprise the OSLT Board of Directors.

Rick Gardner moved and Rob Bird seconded that the new Board appoints Mary-Lu Leveroni as Treasurer. Motion passed unanimously.

Joe Jaynes will complete the paperwork required to incorporate as a non-profit organization. Then OSLT will determine whether to form an official partnership with the Friends of A1A and become 501(c)(3) eligible under their umbrella or to follow a path to attain 501(c)(3) status independently.

The group decided to meet at the Anderson-Price Memorial Building for future monthly meetings. We will send a letter to the OB Library thanking them for hosting our meetings for the past 2.5 years and release our hold on the Auditorium for August through December.

Designation Celebration: The Sub-Committee met at 4:30 p.m. today. The celebration will be held on Saturday, October 6, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. at several locations along the corridor. **The next meeting of the sub-committee will be held at 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, August 8, at the Anderson-Price Memorial Building.**

CORRIDOR SOLUTIONS

As outlined at the June meeting, Corridor Solutions created a needs assessment survey form which was distributed to all OSLT members via e-mail on July 25. Paper copies were provided to members who do not use e-mail. Lauren reminded us that Corridor Solutions will recommend actions specific to OSLT, based on the results of the survey. **It is important that all members complete the survey and return them to Paula via US mail by August 10.**

MEMBER COMMENTS

Benny Woodham is overseeing the tree trimming done by the County along Old Dixie/North Beach Street.

The group discussed forming a sub-committee to research ownership of all undeveloped land along the corridor with the intention of contacting the owner to encourage working together. Lauren recommended we re-read the sections of the CMP regarding undeveloped land use.
