Time and Location

June 22, 5:30 p.m., Auditorium, Ormond Beach Library

Attendees

Call to Order and Minutes

Chairman Joe Jaynes called the meeting to order at 5:40 p.m. Rita Press moved for acceptance of the minutes. The motion was seconded by Rick Smith and approved unanimously.

Nominations for Recording Secretary

Tabled until August meeting.

FDOT JPA Supplemental Amendment for \$18,000

Joe Jaynes advised the CAG that the FDOT funding had been processed by the County and the CAG had two options related to hiring a consultant to prepare the Eligibility Application and complete the reformatting of the Corridor Management Plan. The Loop CAG can refrain from hiring immediate consulting services and observe the consultant selection process underway for the Historic Ormond-by-the-Sea Scenic Trail project or the Loop CAG can hire a consultant independent of the process underway for Ormond-by-the-Sea. Martin Press made a motion to observe the consultant selection process for the Historic Ormond-by-the-Sea Scenic Trail Project in order to consider the option of hiring the same consultant that Ormond-by-the-Sea may hire. Rick Smith seconded the motion and the motion was carried unanimously.

Updates on membership and community support

Martin Press indicated that fifteen Applications for Membership had been received and advised the CAG that he had followed-up with the applications by contacting those individuals who sent applications on behalf of the Loop project. Joe Jaynes commended Mr. Press for his follow-up efforts.

Update from County Coordinator

Laureen Kornel indicated that the July 18 FDOT workshop would be an excellent opportunity to establish a positive working relationship with the Bunnell CAG whose project connects with the Loop Corridor.

Member comments

Michelle Gallagher provided information from the Volusia County Comprehensive Plan showing that the Loop corridor is policy constrained by Volusia County and explained how that affects the roadways.

Discussion ensued about the July 13, 2005, 3:00 p.m. meeting that Rick Smith had set up to meet with Ms. Beamer to discuss the speed limit along the corridor, the status of the road in the county comprehensive plan, and signage.

Rick Smith announced that there will tentatively be a “Celebrate the Loop” event along the corridor on October 1, 2005 from 7:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. This will be a one time event which will include running and cycling. Mr. Smith suggested there may be artist booths set up along the corridor and suggested that the CAG consider setting up a booth with information about the scenic corridor.

Regular Meeting Time

Rita Press made a motion to cancel the regularly scheduled July meeting and Rick Smith seconded the motion. All approved unanimously. It was confirmed that the FDOT workshop would be held on July 18, 2005 at 6:00 p.m. at the River Bridge Gardens in Ormond Beach.
