CONSULTANT

Joe Jaynes, CAG Chair, briefly summarized the work of the CAG for members of the public. He then introduced Wes Hoaglund, Redevelopment Manager, from GAI Consultants. Wes made a brief slide presentation showing our vision, goals and objectives, how our group was formed and how to become a member. He then reviewed some of the requirements for submission, including the Corridor Impressions Survey and the Field Inventory Form. Copies of the Corridor Impressions Survey were distributed to audience members asking everyone to encourage friends, co-workers, neighbors, etc. to complete a survey and return it to a CAG member no later than December 20. Completed forms will be given to GAI at the December 21 meeting. Survey results will be compiled and tabulated for inclusion in the Eligibility Phase submission.

Following instructions on how to complete the surveys, Wes opened the floor to audience members to provide input on recommendations for the future, what is important to them and how they would like to manage the roadways into the future.

SCENIC LOOP VIDEO

B.J. Lakey and Doug Myers showed the video documentary they created to showcase the natural and historical resources along The Loop roadways. They created the video as part of a class project at Daytona Beach Community College and donated it to the Ormond Beach Scenic Loop CAG.
