

Responses to SHAC Comments:

Historic Ormond-by-the-Sea (HOSST) Responses

1. The Designation Application/Corridor Management Plan (CMP) has incorporated additional photos and graphics.
2. Benny Woodham, Tomoka State Park Manager was very involved in the development of the CMP.
3. The Community Participation Plan was expanded and the joining of the HOSST and OBSL CAGs into a coherent whole has brought added support to the greater effort.

Further research will need to be done to design appropriate archeological interpretive panels
3. The development pressures continue and the CAG members have remained active in their struggle to preserve the resources. The local Comprehensive Plans are both quite thorough in their range of protections.
4. Many more cultural resources were added to the Designation Application.
5. Adding traffic calming methods to the roadway is a part of the Action Plan.
